1. CALL TO ORDER BY MAYOR DORR - 7:00P.M.

3. WORK SESSION: A work session was held to review Ordinances. It was established that the last Codification of the Ordinances was October 6, 1997 and would supersede all Ordinances prior to October 1, 1997. The Ordinance adopting that Codification of Ordinances of the City of Burlingame, Ks was #1804. Discussion was held as to the best way to go about updating the Ordinance books. City Clerk Smiley stated that the Ordinances that we need to review are the ones following the Codification of the Ordinances #1804 through the most current Ordinance passed which was #2208. She stated that some of those Ordinances have been repealed and others could possibly be repealed. She stated that she would like to start separate sets of books, one for the repealed Ordinances and one for the current Ordinances so that all of the current Ordinances would be together. The League of Kansas Municipalities was used for the previous codification, when contacted in regards to doing it again they gave a quote of \$3320 to codify the Ordinances from 1997 forward, they stated that it would be several months before they could begin. Councilmember DeMars stated that we would need to budget for this. Councilmember Lee stated that we should get bids and time frames from other sources. Councilmember DeMars stated that the only cost efficient way at this time would be for the Councilmembers to come in and go through the books themselves. There are some Ordinances not in numerical order. DeMars stated that previously when a new Ordinance was made to update an old Ordinance previous City Clerk Gilbert would pull the old Ordinance and put it in back of the new Ordinance. Mayor Dorr stated that we need to start somewhere and maybe checking to see what Ordinances are missing would be the first step. DeMars stated that they could come in and log where the Ordinances were located in the book as they went through the process so that the next person that came in would know where to start. A motion was made by DeMars and seconded by Lee to start looking through the Ordinance books and logging any missing or out of place Ordinances.
