

ORDINANCE NO. 1600

AN ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL STOP INTERSECTIONS, AUTHORIZING THE ERECTION OF SIGNS AND REPEALING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME:

SECTION 1. The following street intersections in the City of Burlingame, Kansas, are designated as stop intersections and the Superintendent is directed to cause the erection of signs as indicated.


Intersection	Vehicle Traffic Required to Stop
Dacotah Street and Chase Avenue	Eastbound and Westbound on Chase Avenue
West Banks Avenue and Second Street	Eastbound on West Banks Avenue

SECTION 2. The Superintendent is also directed to cause the erection of a warning sign for Eastbound traffic on West Banks Avenue alerting motorists to the stop sign.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of said City which are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the Osage County Chronicle, the official City newspaper of said City.
