ORDINANCE NO. 1605

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE WATER UTILITY SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME AND SETTING RATES AND CHARGES FOR SERVICE RECEIVED FROM SAID SYSTEM AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1540.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That rates for water delivered, metered and sold by the municipal water department, excluding water sold through special benefit districts, shall be as follows:

A minimum monthly charge of \$10.50 for 2,000 gallons and under Over 2,000 gallons at 50 cents per 100 gallon or \$5.00 per 1,000 gallon

SECTION 2. That rates for water delivered, metered and sold by the municipal water department to special benefit districts shall be as follows:

A minimum monthly charge of \$14.50 for 2,000 gallons and under Over 2,000 gallons at 55 cents per 100 gallon or \$5.50 per 1,000 gallon

That the term, special benefit district, shall mean all water utility lines laid by the City of Burlingame outside of the City limits for which a special rate structure has been set up and shall include the Fostoria water line.

SECTION 3. That the above rates and charges are effective with the monthly billing mailed in January 1992.

SECTION 4. That water haulers will be charged \$7.00 per 1,000 gallon or 70 cents per 100 gallon for plant sales.

SECTION 5. That Ordinance No. 1540 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
